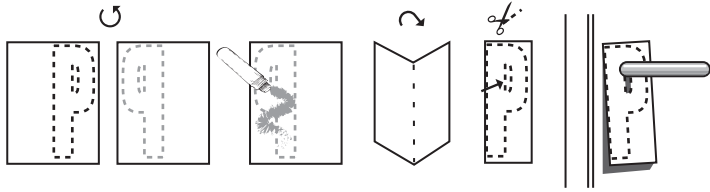


Over the first weekend in November, Platform P present installations and Live Art in multiple bedrooms, corridors, conference rooms, the ballroom and anywhere else we find attractive!

Sunday 6th November, 10am - Artists' Breakfast, open to the public. A chance to reflect and discuss the weekend.

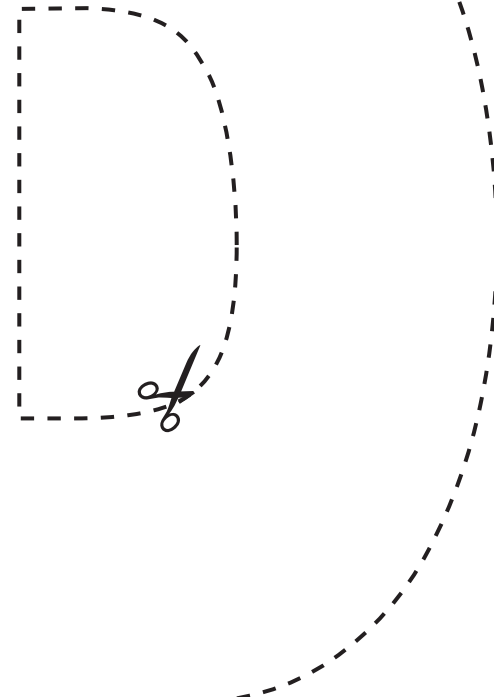
